Congratulations to our Y6 Maths team - Arun, Usmi, Imogen and Jenson - who competed at the Explore Learning challenge last week. They really showed 'Excellence'! Unfortunately they weren't in the top 5 schools in the country, but reading the feedback, they must have been very close:

'I wanted to both congratulate and thank your team for their efforts in the centre round of the Explore Learning's Mathematicians' Award. It was lovely to see such a fantastic teamwork led approach to the competition and to watch the putting their heads to the test to overcome the challenge given.

They showed a lovely effort to use a mixture of all of their strengths including some incredible forward thinking and strategy making. I'd just like to say the teamwork represented from this team caught the attention of all members of staff. Arun, Jenson, Usmi and Imogen all showed fantastic use of questions to challenge given answers and develop ideas of the other team members. They actually scored 15/15 on the teamwork portion of the marking criteria. In regards to finding all the solutions of the 'U' shape problem, they represented 13 accurate solutions out of the 15 solutions possible. A big well done to them! In total, Winkfield scored 29/35 marks.'

Last Friday our Y5/6 Indoor Athletics team showed great perseverance and application during the events at the Leisure Centre. This year 27 schools entered and they finished mid table, at 16th. Well done team Winkfield, we are proud that you did your best.

Y5 thoroughly enjoyed joining the 'Open The Book' group in presenting the story of Noah to the school. The concentration on the faces of the children watching was impressive and the behaviour was of our usual high standard. I felt very proud to be a part of this new collaboration with St Mary's Church.
