### Dear parents,

As we enter yet another chapter in the 2020 story, I emailed out to parents yesterday a tweak I have made to drop off arrangements which I hope will help make things easier and safer for everyone – please make sure that you (and anyone else who might drop off) are aware of the routes in to school. The biggest change is that <u>children</u> may now come in to school through the pedestrian gate as well as the park gate, rather than walking round through the mud. **Please can parents refrain from parking in the drop off bay to leave it free for others to pull in and drop off.**
