Dear families,

I wanted to start once again by thanking you all for your support and encouragement – we send that back to you all too! I'm proud that our community is working together to keep everyone safe and particularly that we have been able to keep numbers in school low enough to maintain our 2m distancing within the bubbles. Given the higher viral load and transmission rates of the newer variants, our school will be following the advice from SAGE (23/12) in maintaining our hierarchy of control measures, including 2m distancing between children and staff. This has made the staff running the bubbles feel far safer during this time when they have to be in school.

That said, our numbers in the 2 younger bubbles are such that they are now full. As a small school, staffing the bubbles throughout the day is a significant logistical problem, as currently 3 members of staff are off and the number of non-teaching staff has reduced in recent years due to budget cuts.

#### Parent Survey

I have come across some research into remote learning being run by The Education Endowment Foundation – a well-known and well thought of organisation in educational research.

The Education Endowment Foundation, Teacher Tapp and Parent Ping are working together to understand what learning is (or isn't!) happening in pupils' homes while they are unable to attend school in the normal way due to Covid-19. Parents will be asked to download the free Parent Ping app and answer a few simple questions each day, in exchange for opportunities to win Chromebooks and vouchers.

I think this will be a great way to gather feedback nationally, but if more than 60 parents sign up then we get the specific data for our school.
