Dear families,

I think it has been a bit of a shock to many to have our first positive case at Winkfield this week – we have done so well to get a year into the pandemic without having to send children home and I am grateful for that.

It seems timely to remind you once again of the current advice to limit the spread of Coronavirus:

- O The whole household must isolate immediately should someone develop symptoms or test positive to an LFD or PCR test. Children should not be in school whilst awaiting results.
- O No one should be on site who is ill.
- O Children or staff will be isolated and sent home if they become ill.
- O Anyone who has been in close contact will be required to isolate (ie stay at home) for 10 days.
- O Keep socially distanced from other households.
- O Wear a mask on site and in situations where social distancing is not possible.
- O Only mix with your own household or support bubbles indoors.
- O Exercise and recreation outdoors with your household or one other person.

Follow the latest guidance on Self isolation: 'Stay at home: guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection'. Above all, we all need to keep each other safe by keeping to the rules.

Should bubbles or individuals need to self isolate then remote learning will resume. In this case with the whole bubble isolating, the teacher is able to provide a similar level of remote learning as during lockdown via Seesaw. However should individuals be isolating and the class still in operation, the provision will be more limited. It was great to have them join us for Celebration Assembly this morning.

On a positive note, the whole school has really enjoyed seeing the chicks hatching in Reception. This year we have been able to put a webcam on them to enjoy every moment all around the school and through the night too! They have made everyone smile so much – we even have the webcam on the screen in the hall for staff to see during breaks.

I am also really pleased to thank parents for parking more considerately this week and avoiding the zigzags – it has made outside the school feel much safer.

Seeing the children dressed today as their personal heroes has been delightful. They have been really creative and thoughtful about who they have chosen; I am impressed by the range and variety of heroes attending today. Well done everyone!
